

Black & White & Stars Allover

Supply List

This quilt is from my book, *Another Can of Worms*. In class you will not only learn how to make a block for the quilt, but how to redraft and easily rotary cut other sizes, too. This knowledge will help you do the same with other blocks you make in the future.

Besides learning about the block, there is much more information to learn from this quilt – just wait until I point out some of the subtle things to think about when making quilts in the future.

Please bring all of the following to class with you:

- **Sewing Machine**
- **Thread** to blend with your fabrics. Usually, the machines are threaded with a light neutral color. You may use this thread if it suits your fabrics.
- **Rotary Cutter, Mat, & Rulers** – a 12" x 18" mat is suggested. Bring a 6" x 12" or comparable size ruler. A small square (4½" - 6½") may be helpful, too.
- **Tri Recs Tools** – Available for purchase on my website, at your local quilt shop, or during class.
- **Seam ripper**
- **Fabric** – To make just sample blocks, you need the following fabric: three fat quarters – one very light, one very dark, and one bright accent that contrasts with the other two.

The finished size of the **Black & White & Stars Allover** quilt is 51½" x 51½".

To make the **Black & White & Stars Allover** quilt you will need the following amounts of fabric.

I will provide the instructions in your handout so that you may make the quilt if you choose.

There will be only enough time in class to make a couple of blocks.

Fabric

9 Worms (2½" x 40" strips) for Stars	one strip each of nine different fabrics
White Background	⅞ yard
Black Background	⅞ yard
Sashing	½ yard
Cornerstones	4 squares (1¼")
Accent Borders	4 Worms
Border	1⅝ yards
Binding	⅝ yard
Backing	¾ yards
