Where is the block? Squares? Triangles?
It is a mystery until you see Klaudeen's
blocks and discover the surprising and
easy pieced elements. Learn squaring
tricks to keep everything accurate as
you progress.

Sample in photo is 35" square.

Fabrics needed:

Tip: Pick the border first.

Sample shows a dark print with many colors.

Purchase 2 yards for borders. (less if making the small quilt)



Fabric amounts and pre-cutting for a 64" quilt.

2 ½ yards light background; pre-cut five 2" strips and three 4 ¼" strips.

10 fat or regular quarter yards in assorted dark colors to coordinate
with your border fabric. Pre-cut one 2" strip and one 4 ¼" strip of each.

Equipment needed:

Sewing machine, foot pedal, extension cord, etc.

Thread to match background; wind 2 or 3 bobbins.

Rotary cutter, mat and rulers, including 6 or 6 ½" square

Pencil, scissors and pins.

Iron & pad, light, chair cushion and camera optional.
