Supply List

Fabrics for Large Quilt

Finished size: 68" x 81"

4 $\frac{7}{8}$ yards of large-scale purple floral print for blocks, outer border, and binding★

3 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards of small-scale purple floral print for blocks and inner border★

3 $\frac{1}{2}$ yard of yellow print for blocks and middle border★

2 $\frac{1}{4}$ yard of green print for blocks★

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard of dark purple print for block centers

5 $\frac{1}{4}$ yard of fabric for backing**

★ *For class: you only need to bring 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards each of these four fabrics. Bring all of the dark purple print.*



Fabrics for Wall Hanging

Finished size: 53" x 53"

2 yards of red print for blocks and middle border

1 $\frac{5}{8}$ yards of black-with-red dots for blocks

1 $\frac{1}{8}$ yards of black-and-white swirls print for blocks and inner border

1 $\frac{1}{8}$ yards of white-with-black dots for blocks

1 $\frac{3}{8}$ yards of black-with-white dots for outer border and binding**

3 $\frac{1}{4}$ yards of fabric for backing**

***Don't need to bring these fabrics to class.*



Additional supplies

- Rotary cutting mat (18" x 24" or larger)
- Rotary cutter and 6" x 24" ruler (needs to be at least 24" long for cutting strips)
- 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square ruler or 6" x 12" ruler
- Sewing machine
- Iron and ironing board
- Neutral thread for patchwork
- Basic Sewing Supplies (scissors, pins, needles, thread, seam ripper, pencil, paper, any special tools you use)

(Optional: We'll be cutting strips and you may find the fabric is more cooperative when it's starched. This can be done by first covering your ironing board with a large towel. Spray starch on the back of dry fabric until it is literally wet. Let the starch soak in a bit, and then iron.)
