Please complete **PARTS ONE (1) AND TWO (2)** of this form for each photograph you wish to enter.

Please be sure you have completely read and that you thoroughly understand the Wilderness Wildlife Week™ Photography Contest **RULES & REGULATIONS** prior to submitting your photograph(s).

Before submitting your photo, did you remember to:

- _____ Mount your photograph on foam core or 4 ply mounting board. *A finished entry size must be a minimum of 8 inches (in any direction) and maximum of 20 inches (in any direction). Entries may be flush mounted or matted.*
- _____ Affix an adequate amount of Velcro™ tape (hook/rough side) to the back of your entry for hanging.
- _____ Affix "PART TWO" of the entry form to the back of your photograph
- _____ Distinguish the top of your photograph by marking either an UP arrow or writing the word TOP on the back of your photograph.
- _____ Remove any personal identification from the front of your photograph (photo or matting).
- _____ Complete to bring with you when submitting your photograph "PART ONE" of the entry form.

Divisions:

1. **Amateur** – Open to anyone who does NOT earn money from photography. Photo must fit the overall contest theme of nature, wildlife, and wilderness (no pet, posed portraits or studio photographs).
2. **Professional** – Open to anyone who earns ANY money from photography. Photo must fit the overall contest theme of nature, wildlife, and wilderness (no pet, posed portraits or studio photographs).
3. **Best Landscape or Seascape** – Open to everyone. Photo must be a broad view of land or sea.
4. **Best Wildlife Scene** – Open to everyone. Photo can be of any wildlife subject (no pet, posed portraits or studio photographs).
5. **Best Youth and Young Adult Image** – Open to all **under** the age of 18. Photo must fit the overall contest theme of nature, wildlife, and wilderness (no pet, posed portraits or studio photographs).
6. **Nature's Wonders in Black & White** – Open to everyone. Photo can be of any wildlife subject or scene (no pet, posed portraits or studio photographs). Any entry must be in black and white.
7. **Great Smoky Mountain Landmark** – Open to everyone. Photo must be of a Great Smoky Mountain landmark (ex. Cades Cove, Walker Sisters' Cabin, Mt. LeConte).
