



ROLLING HILLS LANDSCAPE - Carol C. Britt – Batiks Etcetera & Sew What Fabrics – Class # 64

SEE SUPPLIES BELOW:

Use the machine curved strip piecing technique to create a gently curving landscape. A calming, peaceful wall hanging is created. Machine piecing curves is easier than it appears with Carol's techniques. Class will design a small landscape to learn this machine piecing technique and how to plan the location of colors. Quilting and finishing will also be discussed. (Experienced beginner, intermediate and advanced.)

An **optional kit** with similar fabrics to the photo will be available for \$75. The kit includes fabrics, borders, binding and the pattern. This will make a wall quilt approximately 29" x 39". Carol will show how to design your own landscape using the fabric listed below. The size will vary depending on your design.

Supplies: Mountain Home pattern \$10 from teacher or order from www.batiks.com. Good fabric scissors (must cut cleanly through at least 6 layers of fabric), straight pins, fabric markers & chalk pencils, medium gray or beige sewing thread, seam ripper, rotary cutter and mat, masking tape, sewing machine in good working condition, extension cord, and 1-1/2 yards white fleece or cotton flannel to use as a design wall. Two steam irons & boards in are provided in each classroom for us to share.

Design Your Own Landscape: 100% cotton pre-washed and pressed. Bring lots of choices. 1/4 yd, fat eights, or fat quarters are sufficient for piecing. Scraps can be used if they are a minimum of 20" long and 4" wide. Bring 4 - 8 fabric choices each for foreground, mid-ground, background, and sky. Think of forest, fields, hills, mountains, and sky. Consider a time of year as a theme. Water, sand, and fields of flowers are also possibilities. Cottons may be solid or printed. You will choose from these pieces and not all will be used. More choices are better than few choices. Border fabric will also be needed but cannot usually be planned in advance. 1/2 - 1 yd. is usually sufficient for borders.
