

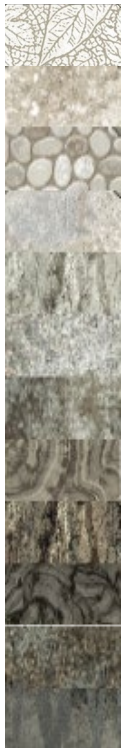
Winter Solstice lap quilt

Supply List

Please bring the following to class with you:



A —lightest value	$\frac{1}{4}$ yd or fat $\frac{1}{4}$
B — 2 nd lightest value	$\frac{2}{3}$ yd
C —3 rd lightest value	$\frac{1}{2}$ yd
D —4 th lightest value	$\frac{5}{8}$ yd
E —5 th lightest value	$\frac{5}{8}$ yd
F —6 th lightest value	$\frac{5}{8}$ yd
G —7 th lightest value	$\frac{3}{4}$ yd
H —8 th lightest value	$\frac{5}{8}$ yd
I —9 th lightest value	$\frac{5}{8}$ yd
J —10 th lightest value	$\frac{7}{8}$ yd
K —11 th lightest value	$\frac{5}{8}$ yd
L —darkest value	$\frac{1}{3}$ yd



- recommended fabric choices are busy tonal prints to include 12 different values from light to dark in gray, gray/taupe or gray/blue. Stonehenge or batiks work well.
- sewing machine in good working order, with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot
- neutral thread to match
- rotary cutter, ruler and cutting mat
- basic sewing supplies, including pins, seam ripper, tape measure and wooden presser/point turner or Clover Hera marker
