



Midnight Stars ~ Class Supply List

Welcome to the *Midnight Stars* workshop!! This wonderful little quilt will take you on a tiny piecing adventure! Prepare to fall in love with small blocks!

Follow the fabric preparation directions and cutting instructions below. I'm really looking forward to meeting you soon!!



★Preparations:

* I highly recommend preparing your fabrics with spray sizing!!

This step is optional, but will be an enormous help with every step of piecing, especially with small pieces. Thoroughly and evenly spray, saturating your *fabric yardage before cutting!!* Air dry or press it dry with a dry iron. I use Faultless Magic spray sizing in the blue and white can available at Walmart, Target, and grocery stores. You may need several cans.



* After sizing your fabrics cut your entire quilt following the cutting directions for the quilt size you've chosen.

★Fabrics

- ♥ $\frac{5}{8}$ yard light print for blocks and borders.
 - ♥ $\frac{1}{3}$ yard black print for blocks, border and binding.
 - ♥ (7) assorted 6" x 22" black prints for blocks and pieced border.
 - ♥ $\frac{3}{4}$ yard backing.

★Cutting Instructions

✂ From light print for Sawtooth Star blocks, and borders:

*Cut (3) 2" x WOF strips: subcut (112) 2" x 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " rectangles for Flying Geese units in Sawtooth Stars.

*Cut (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for light print inside border.

*Cut (6) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips: subcut (96) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares for Connector Corner (**CC**) units in Flying Geese pieced border.
~ subcut (112) 1" x 1" squares Sawtooth Star block corners.

From remaining fabric.....

*Cut a total of (4) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for half blocks in rows 2 & 4.

- ✂ From EACH of (7) assorted black prints for blocks and Flying Geese pieced border:
- *Cut (4) 1½" x 1½" squares for Sawtooth Star block centers. (28 total)
 - *Cut (6) 2" x 1¼" rectangles for Flying Geese in pieced border. (42 total)
 - *Cut (32) 1" x 1" squares for Flying Geese in Sawtooth Star blocks. (224 total)

- ✂ From black print for Flying Geese pieced border, outer border and binding:
- *Cut (2) 2" x WOF strips for outer border.
 - *Cut (2) 2" x WOF strips for binding.
 - *Cut (1) 2" x WOF strip: subcut (6) 2" x 1¼" rectangles for Flying Geese units in pieced border.

From remaining fabric....

- *Cut a total of (4) 1" x 1" squares for cornerposts in the Flying Geese pieced border.

★Supplies You'll Need:

Tokens of the Past: Two Color Classics pattern by Heartspun Quilts (available the day of class), click style pencil, basic sewing supplies, sewing machine in good working order, quarter inch foot for your machine, rotary cutter and medium size mat.

Please bring a 3½" *OR* 4½" square ruler. (I recommend Creative Grid rulers)

Also...Optional but very helpful are.... Wing Clipper ruler, Acorn Seam Align glue and a small bottle of Best Press or Flatter starch, if you have them. I will also have them in class.
