Learn paper piecing the Judy Neimeyer way. Learn to paper piece high contrast spikes and backgrounds, then join them on a slight curve to create a project with movement and color.

SUPPLY LIST:

Pattern required: Wicker Basket by Judy Neimeyer Quilting and Charm Elements #17 (available in class - \$20)

Creative Grids Wave Ruler (optional but available in class for \$21.50)

Fabric requirements:

- 1 3/8 of border and binding fabric
 - 48 strips at 2 1/2" (can use a Quiltworx strip set or cut your own in an assortment of high contrast colors)
- 1) Add-a-quarter ruler (available in class, price varies based on size)
 - 2) Glue Pen (Sewline is preferable and will be available in class, \$8.50)
 - 3) Template plastic – 3 1/2" x 12" (available in class)
 - 4) Large paper clips
 - 5) Flowerhead pins
 - 6) 2 – Gallon size ziplock bags (4)

Rotary cutter with sharp blade (60mm preferable), cutting mat, iron and pressing pad, 70/10 needles, 60 weight piecing thread, scotch tape, scissors and sewing machine in good working order.
