Wool Felt Ornaments

Working with wool felt is a FUN and easy way to complete a hand embroidery project! Michele will teach you how to use freezer paper to make templates for this project (and other appliqué projects). Learn how to sew a buttonhole stitch with embroidery floss to appliqué the design, and to sew the 5” square together. The completed project can be used as a coaster or IF a ribbon hanger is added, then it’s an ornament. Tips and techniques on working with wool felt will be discussed.

Kit includes:

- * Pattern
- * Wool felt (colors as shown in photo) to make 2 ornaments (your choice – 6 options)
- * One skein of DMC black embroidery floss
- * One size 22 chenille needle
- * 8” of 3/8” wide black grosgrain ribbon

- * Straight pins
- * 1” x 6” ruler
- * Small sharp scissors (for fabric)
- * Small pair of scissors (for paper)
- > ***If needed or desired:*** a thimble; portable battery operated light; magnifying glass; and/or bifocals.
