




## Kentucky Crossroads ~ Class Supply List

Welcome to the *Kentucky Crossroads* workshop!! This quilt looks great in any two color combination OR with scrappy assorted color blocks. Choose one background fabric, and a bunch of different prints in your favorite color(s). Then, follow the fabric preparation directions and cutting instructions. I'm really looking forward to meeting you soon!!



### ★Preparations:

\* I highly recommend preparing your fabrics with spray sizing!! This step is optional, but will be an enormous help with every step of piecing. Thoroughly and evenly spray, saturating your *fabric yardage before cutting!!* Air dry or press it dry with a dry iron. I use Faultless Magic Light Hold spray sizing in the blue & white can available at Walmart, Target, and grocery stores. You may need several cans.



\*After sizing your fabrics cut your entire quilt following the cutting directions below. It will be very helpful to sort, label and bag the pieces for the *Kentucky Crossroads* blocks, and Framed Squares Sashing blocks, as it will help immensely with assembly.



### ★Fabrics & Cutting Instructions:

- ♥ 7<sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> yards of light print for blocks, sashing and border.
- ♥ 9" x 22" piece EACH of (42) assorted medium and/or dark prints for blocks. (Choose (42) assorted prints of one color OR (42) assorted colors.)
- ♥ 5/8 yard of dark print for binding.
- ♥ 5 1/2 yards for backing.

### ✎ Cutting Instructions ✎

Label seven zip-bags A - F and Framed Squares. Put the cut pieces in each bag for easy, organized assembly in class.

✂ From light print for blocks, sashing and border:

\*Cut (9) 8 1/2" x WOF strips ~ subcut (71) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" sashing strips.

\*Cut (9) 5 1/2" x WOF strips for border.

\*Cut (11) 4 1/4" x WOF strips~subcut (84) 4 1/4" squares, crosscut once  diagonally for **A**

\*Cut (11) 2 1/2" x WOF strips ~ subcut (168) 2 1/2" squares for **B**

\*Cut (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips ~ subcut (30) 2 1/2" squares for center of sashing block

- \*Cut (21) 2" x WOF strips ~ subcut (420) 2" squares for **C**
- \*Cut (3) 2" x WOF strips ~ subcut (42) 2" squares for **E**
- \*Cut (9) 2" x WOF strips ~ subcut (180) 2" squares for Half Square Triangles in sashing blocks

✂ From EACH of (42) assorted dark prints for blocks:

- \*Cut (4) 2" x 3½" rectangles for **F**
- \*Cut (10) 2" squares for **D**

Choose (30) of the assorted dark prints and from EACH print.....

- \*Cut (6) 2" squares for Half Square Triangles in Framed Squares sashing blocks.

✂ From dark print for binding:

- \*Cut (9) 2¼" x WOF strips for binding.

✂ From backing:

- \*Cut (2) 2¾ yard pieces.

### ★Supplies You'll Need:

*Kentucky Crossroads* pattern by Heartspun Quilts (required & available the day of class), click style pencil, basic sewing supplies, sewing machine in good working order, quarter inch foot for your machine, rotary cutter and medium size mat, and Post-It notes...small size about 1½" square is fine.

Please bring a 4½" square and 8½" square or larger square ruler (I recommend Creative Grid rulers.) *Optional but very helpful* .....are a 3½" x 12½" Creative Grid ruler, 4½" Bloc-Loc Half Square Triangle ruler, Acorn Seam Align glue and a small bottle of Best Press starch, only if you starched your fabric prior to cutting it as recommended.
