Mola is the style of applique done by the Kuna (indigenous people of Panama), who live on the San Blas Islands off the coast of Panama and in Columbia. This intricate style of applique is worn as the front and back panel of the Kuna women's blouses, and now are also made as wall hangings. Using a pattern from the two traditional designs I provide, you'll cut and sew your own 2-color Mola, while also considering how to expand your horizons for future projects.
