Dear Pigeon Forge Residents:

Today, Sevier County Mayor Larry Waters issued Executive Order 29, which extends the mandate requiring face coverings in certain circumstances in Sevier County through Aug. 29. The order is posted on www.seviercountyttn.gov. All Sevier County residents, employees and visitors are required to wear face coverings in public. This action is necessary to ensure that our business operations are uninterrupted and to allow Sevier County Schools to reopen later this month.

Unfortunately, we still have much work to do in Sevier County and Pigeon Forge as it relates to mitigating the spread of Covid-19, but we can do it. Wearing a face covering, along with frequent hand washing, increased disinfecting of frequently-used surfaces, and proper social distancing are the only known ways to combat this illness.

We kindly ask that each of you please do your part to make our community safer. Your continued contributions to Pigeon Forge's wellbeing is appreciated and essential to moving past this public health crisis.
