Dear Pigeon Forge Residents:

Today, Sevier County Mayor Larry Waters issued Executive Order 39, which once again extends the mandate requiring face coverings in certain circumstances in Sevier County. This extension continues through Oct. 30. The order is posted on www.seviercountyttn.gov. All Sevier County residents, employees and visitors are required to wear face coverings in public. Our health department officials remind us that wearing a mask is one of the most effective means we have to slow the spread of Covid-19. Masks and other safety precautions are necessary to keep our businesses and schools open.

If you feel unwell, have been exposed to someone who has been diagnosed with Covid-19, or have been near someone who has potentially been exposed to the virus, please get tested. Free tests are available at the Sevier County Health Department. We know that this virus spreads from person to person, so it is imperative that we isolate confirmed cases as soon as possible.

As we approach the cooler months and temperatures find us indoors more often and closer together, we each have a greater responsibility to fight the spread of Covid-19. Please take every precaution to protect yourself and your neighbors.
