SUPPLY LIST:

FABRIC NEEDED:

White for background, 3 yards. (More if you plan to make your quilt bigger). Pre-cut 68 – 3 ½” squares and 4 – 6” squares. Cut the 3 ½” squares once on the diagonal (corner to corner) to yield 136 triangles.

Black with bits of white print to trade with others in class. Trade is optional, but so much fun! ½ yard each of 4 different prints. Try to find some with curvy designs, like vines or flowers and some with geometric designs, such as little triangles, plus signs +, boxes or dots. Pre-cut all into 6” squares.

Your choice of color(s) for the small squares (sample shows many colors). Scraps or fat quarters, cut into 3” squares. Sample required 136 squares. You will need about 30 for class.

SEWING SUPPLIES:

- Sewing machine, foot pedal, extension cord, etc.
- Rotary cutter, mat & rulers. A 6 ½” quilters rule is handy in this class. Teacher will bring some to use in class.
- Scissors and pins
