FABRIC:

I recommend 2-3 fat quarters of either hand dyed or batiks fabrics in purple, red violets. We will color on these prior to fussy cutting out the pieces that we use, so having a little extra gives you room to play. One of them will also be used as a base on which to fuse the appliques on. Be sure that there are light colors as well as medium to dark values in your choices.

Additionally, you will want scraps of yellows to orange, white, and green in hand dyed or batik fabrics.

Background: I used on that was about 20" wide by about 28" tall in green.

OTHER SUPPLIES:

- Misty Fuse fusible adhesive – 2 yards 20" wide or 1 package.
- Pencil
- Freezer paper – 1 yard
- Scissors for paper and fabric
- **HIGHLY recommended: A ceramic bladed cutter by Slice**
- **Optional:** Your own set of Inktense, Neocolor II, Fabrico markers in #125 Garnet, #116 Peony Purple, and # 163 Forest Green.

Note: We will not get to quilting in the 1 day workshop – machines are not required.
