

2022 A Mountain Quiltfest Guidelines for Quilt Show Entries June 7-9, 2022

(Quilt Delivery Dates & Return Information on Pg 4)

A Mountain Quiltfest is free and open to the public. There are no fees for entering a quilt in our show. The quilt must have never been entered in a previously judged category in A Mountain Quiltfest. There is NO limitation to the number of quilts that can be entered by one person or the number of quilts that can be entered into one category. **However, each entry MUST HAVE a separate entry form.**

Please Note: All entries, regardless of size, must have a 4" sleeve sewn to the upper back of the quilt, edge to edge. **Quilts without a sleeve will be returned to owner, no exceptions. For quilts longer than 110", the top edge of the sleeve must be 110" from the floor.** Quilts may be turned up from the bottom by basting or using safety pins only.

All quilts must be entered by the maker(s) of the top. All entries must be quilted through all three (3) layers. Tied quilts will not be accepted (except for Youth Category – Q). **A photo must accompany all entries.**

The entries will be hung as space permits, but all accepted entries will be displayed. **A Mountain Quiltfest reserves the right to reject, re-categorize or refuse to display any entry.** Note: Not all ribbons/prize monies will be awarded if a category has five or fewer entries. The quilt show will be professionally judged before the start of the show, and all decisions of the judges are final.

A. Large Hand Quilted – The quilt must be 100% hand quilted. The perimeter of the quilt is 300 inches or larger.

B. Small Hand Quilted – The quilt must be 100% hand quilted. The perimeter of the quilt is less than 300 inches.

C. Large Pieced – The piecing must be predominant over other techniques in amount and effect. The perimeter of the quilt is 276 inches or larger.

D. Medium Pieced – The piecing must be predominant over other techniques in amount and effect. The perimeter of the quilt is larger than 200 inches but less than 276 inches.

E. Small Pieced – The piecing must be predominant over other techniques in amount and effect. The perimeter of the quilt is a maximum of 200 inches.

F. Applique – The applique work must be predominant over other techniques in amount and effect.

G. Large Mixed Techniques – The quilt must include a balanced variety of media (i.e., applique, pieced, and hand or machine embroidery). The perimeter of the quilt is 250 inches or larger.

H. Small Mixed Techniques – The quilt must include a balanced variety of media (i.e., applique, pieced, and hand or machine embroidery). The perimeter of the quilt is less than 250 inches.

J. Modern – The quilt includes, but is not limited to, the use of bold colors and prints, high contrast and graphic areas of solid color, improvisational piecing, minimalism, expansive negative space, and alternate grid work. The quilt can include modernized traditional blocks. This category is exempt from the Quilted by Another restriction.

K. Art/Creative – The quilt, designed by the quilt creator, which presents an original idea or interprets artwork from another medium, without duplicating the work of others. This category is exempt from the Quilted by Another restriction.

L. Extra Large Quilted by Another – The quilt is quilted by someone other than the person who made the quilt top. The perimeter of the quilt is 350 inches or larger.

M. Large Quilted by Another – The quilt is quilted by someone other than the person who made the quilt top. The perimeter of the quilt is a minimum of 300 inches and less than 350 inches.

N. Medium Quilted by Another – The quilt is quilted by someone other than the person who made the quilt top. The perimeter of the quilt is larger than 250 inches and less than 300 inches.

P. Small Quilted by Another – The quilt is quilted by someone other than the person who made the quilt top. The perimeter of the quilt is a maximum of 250 inches.

Q. Youth (ages 17 & under) – The quilt can be any size and must be composed of a minimum of at least 2 layers. The quilt must be pieced and quilted or tied in its entirety by the youth. The youth must designate their age on the entry form.

R. Large Themed Quilt – The quilt must meet the theme of the year (i.e., Christmas Quilts, two color quilts, log cabin quilts, etc.). This category is exempt from the Quilted by Another restriction. The theme will be announced each year at A Mountain Quiltfest for the following year. The perimeter of the quilt is 250 inches or larger.

S. Small Themed Quilt – The quilt must meet the theme of the year (i.e., Christmas Quilts, two color quilts, log cabin quilts, etc.). This category is exempt from the Quilted by Another restriction. The theme will be announced each year at A Mountain Quiltfest for the following year. The perimeter of the quilt is less than 250 inches.

T. Embroidery – The quilt must be **predominately** machine or hand embroidered. Quilts can be of any size. A quilt entered in this category is exempt from the Quilted by Another restriction.

2022 Theme – String Time in the Smokies

String piecing is a patchwork quilt-making technique that is accomplished by sewing multiple fabrics together to create a “strip set” that looks just like a portion of a quilt block. The strings or strips can be any color combination, from scrappy to graduated color families. The strips do not need to be uniform width. The strip set can be cut apart to yield segments that replace two or more pieces of fabric. The quilt must be an interpretation of string quilts and should be recognizable as a string quilt. The category is split into large and small quilts. Quilts will be accepted that meet the theme of the year’s criteria and are clearly recognizable as a string quilt when completed. A large quilt is a quilt with a perimeter of 250 inches or larger. Small quilt is a quilt with a perimeter of 249 inches or less. These categories are exempt from the Quilted by Another restriction. Prizes awarded for each category (large and small) are 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place.

Hand Deliver Your Quilt to A Mountain Quiltfest – quilts will be accepted on Friday, May 13, 2022 from 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. or Saturday, May 14, 2022 from 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. ONLY. Please be aware there will most likely be heavy traffic in Pigeon Forge so please allow for plenty of time to arrive at the office within the designated time frame. NO QUILTS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 2:00 P.M. on Saturday.

1. Quilts may be delivered to the Pigeon Forge Office of Special Events, located in the Information Center at Stoplight #5 in Pigeon Forge, TN. The physical address is 3107 Parkway, Pigeon Forge, TN 37863.
2. Bring with you a completed registration form and photo for each entry.
3. Please mark the preferred method of quilt return on your entry form and follow the appropriate instructions listed below.

Quilt Return

Quilts may be picked up or shipped back to you at the end of the show. Your selection must be made on the entry form for your quilt when shipped or delivered to A Mountain Quiltfest. Please see directions below for quilt return.

Have Your Quilt Shipped Back from A Mountain Quiltfest:

1. If you request your quilt be mailed back to you and you included pre-paid postage, it **will not** be available for personal pickup. **Absolutely no exceptions.**
2. Include in your original shipment, or hand deliver with your quilt, a separate self-addressed mailing label and pre-paid postage label for the return of your quilt. If you hand deliver your quilt to A Mountain Quiltfest, please remember to bring with you a box for the return of your quilt. We do not accept checks for return postage. Failure to comply will result in the disqualification of your entry.
3. Insurance coverage is your responsibility. Please tell your shipping carrier to include your desired amount of insurance with your pre-paid postage label.

Pick Your Quilt up from A Mountain Quiltfest:

1. Pick up for quilts will be available at the LeConte Center at Pigeon Forge on Thursday, June 9, 2022, from 7:00 p.m. – 7:30 p.m. (Shipping boxes and/or packaging will not be returned with picked-up quilts)
2. Please bring proper identification with you in order to reclaim your quilt.
