Includes - Full color pattern

### SUPPLY LIST:

Machine (if not provided) with 1/4" foot

Neutral color piecing thread on top and in bobbin

Rotary cutter, small mat and a small square ruler (I use a 9-1/2" Omnigrd)

16" piece of batting or muslin to use as a design surface

Straight pins

Your favorite marking pencil or What's My Angle piecing tool - I will have both the tool and Chaco Liners in class (\$10 each)

Pencil with eraser and note taking materials

Pre-cut fabrics - bagged by size if possible

**Use It Up...Make It Do...or Do Without** is the theme! This is a class for you to have fun using up your scraps and stash while you play with color! No one's quilt will look the same. I will show you how you can make easy adjustments on your quilt block to fit YOUR stash.

**BACKGROUND FABRICS:** Assortment of lights (I used creams, whites, pinks and yellows)

Pairs of (2) 5" squares and Sets of (16) 2-1/2" squares (which is (1) 2-1/2" strip). Or, you can bring any combination of 5" squares and 2-1/2" squares—you'll learn how to make it do!

### COLORS:

Please bring a nice color assortment of 5" squares (Set of (2-3) 5" squares of same fabric)

Bring some leftover 2-1/2" squares, 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles and 4-1/2" squares from other projects to incorporate into the blocks. If you prefer to be a little more coordinated—Sets of (8) 2-1/2" squares and Sets of (4) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles.

You don't need to bring the kitchen sink—but bring a nice variety of colors—you will be learning how to make it do. If you are really unsure, you can also bring some FQ to cut up.
