



**Class 35 – PREPARED EDGE MACHINE APPLIQUE – All Levels \$75**

Learn Machine Applique that yields clean and crisp results. Many patterns on the market today combine Applique with piecing to produce beautiful designs, so my machine applique class will allow quilters to take their skills to the next level. This class will help you become confident in this technique that I use in my competition quilts. Applique shapes are turned on a foundation fabric and then applied to the background fabric using a machine stitch and invisible thread. Pattern used will be a semi-wreath design block from Erin Russek's Jane Austin Series. Block is free and is enlarged to 12.5" square. Medallion center can be purchased and downloaded. Students will be given Erin's webpage, One Piece at a Time, to explore additional designs.

Individual blocks show designs ready for machine stitching and an accompanying center medallion type design.
