Jacqueline will be teaching five different patterns during this three-day workshop ranging from Level 4 patterns (Confident Beginner with knowledge of paper piecing) through Level 5 patterns (Intermediate quilters who know how to paper piece and are not afraid of curves) to Level 6 (Intermediate and Advanced quilters with a lot of sewing experience and knowledge of paper piecing.)

**Students have to be fully prepared for a BeColourful class.**

That means that they have to read the pattern at home. It makes so much more sense when they work in class to understand the instructions I show them. They also have to cut all the fabrics for the pattern of their choice and organize the fabrics into zip lock bags. And finally they must cut the paper piece templates and store them into the right zip lock bag with the right fabrics. It works so much nicer at home to get organized in your own space and you can spend time when it is convenient to work on the preparations and you don't have to stress.

Jacqueline strongly advises all quilters who want to take the class to buy the Happiness 2.0 pattern which is a 38" x 38" wall hanging which contains all 13 techniques you will use in ALL of Jacqueline's designs.
