## Description:

This quilt design has the wow factor! Brenda's Half Rect Ruler is used to create the half rectangle units that create the appearance of curves with straight seams. This diverse unit brings an entirely new look to quilts - a great shape that is so easy to construct.
Kit fee: $\$ 30$ which is payable in class. A kit is required and includes Quatrefoil pattern, Triangulations Grids for HST construction and Half Rect Ruler.

Please bring the following items to class:

- Basic Sewing Supplies
- Rotary cutter, mat, and ruler
- Sewing machine


## Fabric Requirements

Star - Red Fabric Chain-1/2 yard
Chain-Green Fabric- $1 / 4$ yard
Background Fabric- 2/3 yard

Fabric Note: If you choose to use batik fabrics, please consider using a printed background fabric. The HalfRect Units are asymmetrical and having a printed background will help you remember to sew the units as mirror images.

Starch: I highly recommend you starch your fabric for the best results! The product I use is StaFlo liquid starch that I mix 50/50 with water. Spray it on the fabric to saturate it and then allow to air dry. I press with a steam iron after it has dried.

(2) $5 \frac{114 " ~}{} \times 10 \frac{112}{2}$ " rectangle HST
(1) $6 \frac{114 " ~ s q u a r e ~ H S T ~}{4}$

Chain - Green Fabric:
(8) $21 / 2$ " squares
(I) $2 \frac{112}{2} \times \mathrm{xWOF}$ strip

Background Fabric:
(1) $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip
(2) $43 / 4 " \times$ WOF strip - HRT
(2) $5 \frac{114 " ~}{4} \times 10^{1 ⁄ 2}$ " rectangle HST
(1) $6 \frac{114 "}{}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square HST

- Star - Red Fabric ( $21 / 4$ yards)
- Background Fabric (3 yards)
- Chain - Green Fabric (1 yard)
- Border Fabric 3 yards
- Binding Fabric $1 / 2$ yard


## Cutting Instructions for entire quilt

## Star - Red Fabrics

- (10) $43 / 4$ " x wof strips - HRT construction
- (3) $5 \frac{1}{1 / 4}$ " $\times$ wof strips - sub-cut into (12) rect $51 / 4$ " x $101 / 2$ "- HST construction
- $61 / 4$ " x wof strips - sub-cut into (6) squares $61 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ - HST construction

Background Fabric

- (10) $43 / 4$ " x wof strips - HRT construction
- (4) $5 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times$ wof strips - sub-cut into (16) rect $51 / 4$ " x $10 \frac{1122}{}$ - HST construction
- $61 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof strips - sub-cut into (6) squares $6 \frac{1}{4 \prime \prime}$ - HST construction
- (8) $21 / 2{ }^{1 \prime \prime} \times$ wof strips - Four Patch construction

Chain - Green Fabric

- (4) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof strips - sub-cut into (64) squares $21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$
- (8) $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof strips - Four Patch Construction

Border Fabric

- (4) $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- (2) $43 / 4$ " x wof strips - HRT construction
- $51 / 4$ " x wof strip - sub-cut into (4) rect $51 / 4$ " x $10 \frac{1122 " ~ H S T ~ c o n s t r u c t i o n ~}{2}$
- (5) $21 / 2$ " $\times$ wof strips - sub-cut into
(16) rectangles $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ and (16) rectangles $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 22^{\prime \prime}$
