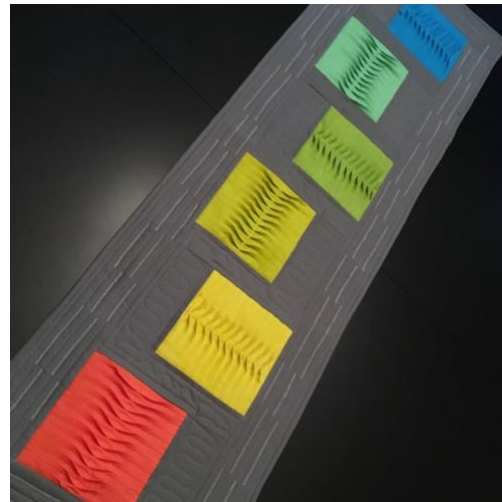

**Description:**

Pleats as Punch Table runner

Learn an interesting twist on your standard quilt block with this show stopping pleating technique! In this half day class, you'll have a ton of fun sewing these EASY pleats by machine, and you'll leave with a completed table runner top.

**Kit Fee: \$10 (for project pattern)**

**Supplies Needed:**

- 3/4 yard of background fabric
- Fat quarters of 6 different fabrics for the colors inside of the folds
- a sewing machine with all accessories (empty bobbins, a 80/12 universal sewing needle, and foot pedal and all cords)
- A quarter inch piecing foot for your machine brand.
- Scissors (thread snips)
- Rotary Cutter and mat
- Scissors
- Ruler (at least a 6 inch ruler and a longer one for the long strips)
- Thread to match your fabrics
- Pins
- Batting and a fabric backing (both should be 15 x 36)
