Description:

Make a gorgeous dimensional flower quilt all by machine in this half day class! You'll learn how to create the quilted background and the gathered flowers and leaves in class. Everyone will ask you where you learned how to make such pretty flowers. Uses the gathering foot for your machine, and a couple stitches by hand to attach them.

Kit Fee: None

Supplies Needed:

- A fat quarter for your background
- Three fat quarters of green for leaves
- Five fat quarters of flower colors
- A fat quarter for your backing
- A piece of batting at least 22 inches square
- a sewing machine with all accessories (empty bobbins, an 80/12 universal sewing needle, and foot pedal and all cords)
- A quarter inch piecing foot for your machine brand.
- Scissors (thread snips)
- Rotary Cutter and mat
- Ruler (at least a 6-inch ruler and a longer one for the long strips)
- Thread to match your fabrics and the fabrics inside the folds
- Hand sewing needle
- Pins or clips
