Kit Includes:

20" sq. poster board. , 6" square felt, 2 - 1/2 yd. lengths of rattail cord, Nymo thread and small metal snap, Tacky glue and craft spray adhesive, 10" template plastic for window pattern, 4mm silk ribbon: dark pink, light pink, dusty pink, med. turq., light turq., gold, 3 shades peach, 4 greens, 20" sq drapery-weight moiré (fronts and lining), 12" sq. iron-on interfacing, 12" - 1/4" (6mm) satin ribbon to attach scissors, One 6" double-sided satin ribbon, Beads and 4 needles, tapestry, chenille, embroidery, beading, Two 3/8" (6mm) satin ribbons (peach and dusty pink), patterns and handouts.

Students must bring:

- 5 inch embroidery hoop - *very important*
- water erasable pen,
- Chako marker
- Spool of grey thread
- Glue stick
- Variety of sewing needles
- Embroidery and cutting scissors
