Description:

The table runner is a terrific introduction to Quilt-As-You-Go Stained Glass. Rotary cut squares, triangles, and strips are applied to fusible interfacing to create the body of the table runner. Freezer paper templates are used to cut the appliqué wild rose pieces for each end of the design. This is a very busy 6 hour class period. Many students will not actually sew in class.

A kit is required and includes the Wild Roses Table Runner Pattern Kit fee: \$10 which is payable in class.

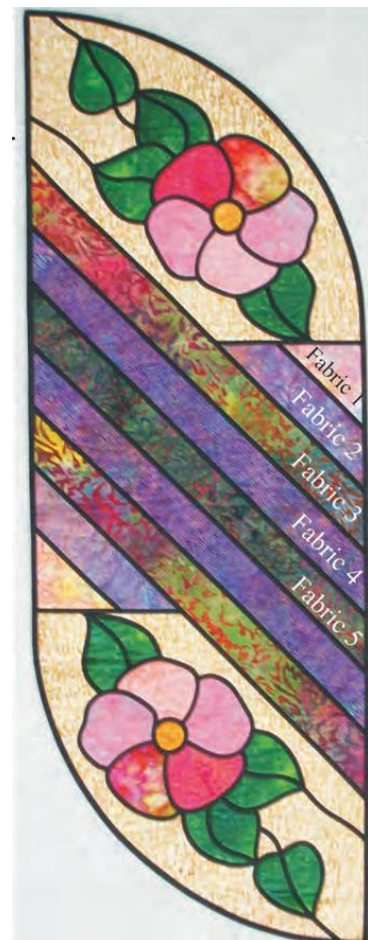
Finished Size: 16" x 4.5"

- Background 2 squares 16 ½"
- Fabric 1- 4 ½" square
- Fabric 2- 2 rectangles 2 ¼" x 26"
- Fabrics 3- 2 rectangles 2 ¼" x 26"
- Fabric 4- 2 rectangles 2 ¼" x 26"
- Fabric 5-1 rectangle 2 ¼" x 26"
- Rose Fabrics
- Yellow Center- 2" x 4" piece
- Pink Petals- 5 pieces 4" x 8"
- Green Leaves-8" x 16" piece
- Backing 20" X 49"
- Batting
- Binding
- Woven Fusible Interfacing (Stacy Shape Flex)
- Clover Fusible Bias Tape - 11 yards - 1 reel
