We will discuss several options for applique' to include raw edge, machine applique', and hand applique with a demonstration on my favorite technique of freezer paper and starch.

- Clover bias maker size ¼"
- Clover mini iron

- Yardage for quilt construction:
- 2-1/2 yd Background
- ¾ yd Dark pink for large blocks, Friendship star points, applique' flower
- ½ yd Green ½ yd Blue for flying geese around applique' flowers
- 1/4 yard each of Yellow, Purple, Orange and Light Blue for large blocks
- 1/2 yard (large scraps) of various colors for leaves and flowers

NOTE I did not use a border on my piece. If you'd like a border, I'd suggest at least ¾ yards.

- ¾ yd Binding
