Description:

Fun and speedy Jelly Roll design that uses the light, medium and dark fabric values to create a dynamic secondary pattern.

Brenda is the Queen of Strip Piecing, having designed and written 13 books using 2 1/2" strips. She will teach you her technique to ensure accuracy when sewing pre-cut strips together - they may not be 2 1/2" wide!

- Finished Size: 62" x 76"
- Fabric Requirements and Cutting Instructions: 1 roll of 40 - 2 1/2" strips
- The quilt is most successful when the fabrics range from light to dark:
- 10 strips light
- 10 strips medium/light 10 strips medium/dark 10 strips dark
- Accent 1/3 yard
- First Border - 6 strips 1 1/2" x wof
- Final Border 2 yards
- 2 strips 6 1/2" x 68" - lengthwise cut 2 strips 6 1/2" x 66" - lengthwise cut
- this allows for a lengthwise cut border and bias binding from the remainder

Kit fee: \$10 which is payable in class

Supply List

- A kit is required and includes Trapezium pattern, and Trapezium template
- Sewing Machine
- Thread to blend with fabrics
- Rotary Cutter
- Cutting Mat (18" x 24")
- Ruler (14" is sufficient)
- Finger Presser
- Seam Ripper
- Pins
- Scissors or thread snips

- Qtool Sewing Edge –optional Pencil or Ultrafine Sharpie Marker
- Marking Pencil - the white mechanical fabric pencil by Fons and Porter or Sewline are great!
