Supplies needed:

- At least ten 8" squares of good cotton fabric in solid or solid like colors
- one fat quarter of good cotton fabric in solid or solid like colors
- a clear plastic ruler at least 8 inches long (like Omnigrid rulers)
- strong thread to match your fabric (I like 40 or 50 weight threads)scissors and thread snips
- a sewing machine with all accessories (empty bobbins, a 80/12 universal sewing needle, and foot pedal and all cords)
- gathering foot for your machine brand (You can do this technique without it, but it is a lot easier with it)
- a double needle for your sewing machine (Schmetz sells a set of 3 different sizes, which is what I recommend to buy)
