


QUILT SUBMISSION



THEME QUILTS

2024 THEME QUILT: WHAT'S THE POINT

Call them spikes, points or spears, they are a design feature frequently used in many stunning quilts. Whether used as a part of a border, as an accent piece or as the central focus, spikes can bring a look of strength and power to a quilt. These spikes consist of one color or could be made from several fabrics to present a rainbow. The spikes must be the predominant feature in the quilt.

The category will be divided into large and small quilts. A Large Quilt will have a perimeter of 250 inches or larger. A Small Quilt will have a perimeter of less than 250 inches. These 2 categories are exempt for the Quilted By Another Restriction. Prizes will be awarded for both Large and Small Theme Quilt Category.



2025 THEME QUILT: GAGGLE OF GEESE

Flying Geese is a traditional quilt block what consists of a series of triangular shapes that form the appearance of flying geese. It is believed to have originated in the United States in the late 19th century. Flying Geese quickly became popular due to the versatility and ease of use of this design. There is also a legend that the Flying Geese pattern was used as a code by enslaved people who escaped through the Underground Railroad. The pattern was said to indicate the direction of travel, following the migration of geese. The Flying Geese must be the predominant feature in the quilt.

The category will be divided into large and small quilts. A Large Quilt will have a perimeter of 250 inches or larger. A Small Quilt will have a perimeter of less than 250 inches. These 2 categories are exempt from the Quilted by Another Restriction. Prizes will be awarded for both Large and Small Theme Quilt Category.







QUILT APPRAISALS

Certified quilt appraiser, **Cynthia** (**Cindy**) **Stuart**, will again provide professional quilt appraisals for anyone wishing to have their quilts appraised. Quilt appraisals will be available by appointment only, on June 3-6, 2024.

Cindy is a quilt historian who began quilting in the 1990s and became interested in quilt restoration after repairing a wedding quilt for her mother. In order to restore quilts, one must learn how to date fabrics and use quilting techniques consistent with those used in the past.

Cindy will be providing appraisals by appointment only. To schedule an appointment, please contact Cindy directly by calling (865) 386-0940, or email her at

<u>cynthiakstuart@gmail.com</u>. Cindy will provide you with all of the necessary paperwork and schedule your appointment.

All appraisals will be conducted in private at the LeConte Center at Pigeon Forge. Please inquire at the Information Desk when you arrive for directions to the appraisal room. If you have not made a prior appointment, but would like to see if Cindy can work you in, contact her directly at the number listed above.

The appraisal fee for **one quilt is \$60**. Verbal consultations are **\$25/each**.
