### **Class Description**

Janome Sewing Machines Provided in Class

This little quilt sparkles with traditional charm and is the perfect class for any quilter who wants to learn how to make a Feathered Star block. Nancy takes students through a step-by-step class, with rotary cutting and piecing techniques for making accurate triangle squares. Her methods make short work of this tricky-looking block.

Quilt size: 44" x 44".

**Materials Fee for pattern: \$10 (payable in class, cash preferred)**

#### **Fabric** (*yardage requirements based on 42" wide fabric*)

- 1 yard of light background for star feathers, setting pieces, and border blocks
- 5/8 yard of red print for star feathers and border blocks
- 1-1/8 yards of [blue print](#) for star points, outer border, and binding\*
- 3/8 yard of large floral for center of star block and border blocks
- 3/4 yard of check fabric for middle border and border blocks
- 3/8 yard of navy floral for inner border
- Backing - 2 7/8 yards (Backing fabric and batting are not needed for class.)
- Batting 47" x 47" piece

#### **Supply list**

- Basic sewing supplies (scissors, pins, needles, thread, seam ripper, pencil, paper, utility scissors, small baggies and any special tools you use)
- Rotary Cutter (45 mm)
- Cutting Mat (12" x 18")
- Rulers: 6" x 12" ruler and 6½" square ruler with a diagonal line
- Trimming rulers: Corner Trimmer by Marti Mitchell *or* Triangle Trimmers by Fons and Porter
- Sewing Machine, iron, and ironing board

**Materials Fee for pattern: \$10 (payable in class, cash preferred)**

*Before class, cutting the pieces listed under "Cutting" on page 2. You will not need the border strips or binding strips for class.*

## Cutting

From the light background, cut:

- (6) squares, 9" x 9"
- (4) squares, 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ "; cut once diagonally to yield 8 half-square triangles (label as A1)
- (4) squares, 2" x 2"; cut once diagonally to yield 8 half-square triangles (label as B1)
- (4) squares, 6 $\frac{1}{8}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{8}$ " (label as D)
- (1) square, 11 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 11 $\frac{1}{4}$ "; cut twice diagonally to yield 4 quarter-square triangles (label as E)

From the red print, cut:

- (6) squares, 9" x 9"

From the blue print, cut:

- (4) outer-border strips, 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42"\*
- (5) binding strips, 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 42"\*
- (1) strip, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric (bring to class)

From the large floral, cut:

- (4) squares, 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ "; cut once diagonally to yield 8 half-square triangles (label as F)
- (1) square, 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (label as G)
- (2) squares, 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ "; cut once diagonally to yield 4 half-square triangles\*

From the blue check, cut:

- (4) border strips, 5" x 21 $\frac{3}{4}$ "\*
- (2) squares, 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ "; cut once diagonally to yield 4 half-square triangles\*

From the navy floral, cut:

- (4) border strips, 2" x 21 $\frac{3}{4}$ "\*

**\*Not needed for class.**



The 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square (G) in the center can be replaced with an equal size block.
