A NOTE ABOUT THE BEARS: If a bear approaches your car, keep your windows closed and take pictures from inside. Please do not feed the bears! It confuses their natural habits and violates park regulations.

Park It Forward Parking Fees: Great Smoky Mountains National Park requires parking tags to be displayed on any motor vehicle parked within the park boundaries. Parking rates are \$5 a day (daily parking tag), \$15 for a parking tag valid for up to seven days, and \$40 for an annual parking tag. To purchase a parking tag and see a list of exemptions visit www.nps.gov/grsm/planyourvisit/fees. Revenue from the Park It Forward program provides year-round support focused on improving visitor experiences, protecting resources, and maintaining trails, roads, historic structures and park facilities.

Schedules

Pigeon Forge Mass Transit trolleys operate from 8 a.m. until midnight, early March through the first week of January. Daily operation in January through first week of March is 10 a.m. -10 p.m. Trolleys do not operate on Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve or Christmas Day. Only service animals are allowed on trolleys.



Trams

If the fun of The Island in Pigeon Forge is on your agenda or if you are attending an event at LeConte Center at Pigeon Forge, no need to worry about walking from the city's Municipal Lot. Pigeon Forge Mass Transit's tram service carries riders to both locations and back at no cost.

Paratransit Service

All trolleys are equipped with lifts for wheelchairs and/or other mobility aids and may be accessed at any designated Pigeon Forge Mass Transit stop. For passengers that are unable to get to a trolley stop, a paratransit van may be scheduled for a next-day pickup by calling 865-453-6444.

Paratransit van fare is \$1 per person each way. One personal attendant will be permitted to ride free of charge when accompanying a passenger with limited mobility.

Parking

Free parking is available in three Pigeon Forge city lots:

Patriot Park (186 Old Mill Ave.), the Municipal Lot (2936 Teaster Lane between The Island and LeConte Center), and the Mountain Lot (2989 Teaster Lane). The Patriot Park Lot and the Municipal Lot offer Pigeon Forge Mass Transit trolley stops for boarding.
