## DESCRIPTION

**Garden Blooms quilt – 3 sizes** (small lap to throw). Small lap 39½” x 51½” or large lap 51½” x 63½” or throw 63½” x 75½”

Gather up some pretty floral fat ¼’s and stitch up this cheery bouquet of blooms in one of 3 sizes – no curved piecing required. Flower center is 3-dimensional for added texture.

Kit fee: \$10 for the pattern

## Supply List

- sewing machine in good working order, with a ¼” foot
- neutral thread to match
- clear polyester monofilament thread (MonoPoly by Superior Threads is good)
- rotary cutter, ruler and cutting mat
- basic sewing supplies, including pins, seam ripper, tape measure and wooden presser/point turner or Clover Hera marker
