**Dream Weaver String Quilt**  
(66" x 84")

### DESCRIPTION

Learn how to make vertical/horizontal string blocks with snowballed corners using a no-show polymesh stabilizer, strings, and the Dream Weaver Ruler. Your focus fabric color (light or dark) will determine the look of the quilt. A light focus fabric will enhance the look of the weave, while a darker focus fabric will enhance the snowballed corners.

### SUPPLY LIST

- sewing machine, foot pedal, & power cord
- extra sewing machine needles
- thread & bobbins
- rotary cutter & blades
- ultra fine tip permanent marker...red, blue, or black
- fabric glue stick or washable school glue stick
- scissors
- 1/4" presser foot with guide
- seam ripper
- container for storing strings/strips
- straight pins
- extension cord(s)
- rotating cutting mat if you have one
- 2 ½" to 3" **W** x 12 to 18" **L** ruler
- 6" **W** x 18" **L** or larger ruler
- 9 ½" x 9 ½" square-up ruler

### Fabric Amounts to Complete Quilt

- Background Fabric – 1 ½ yds.

- Inner Border – ½ yd.
- Outer Border – 1 ¼ yds.
- Binding – 2/3 yd.
- Backing – 5 ½ yds. (WOF 42")
- Batting – Twin

### Precutting for Class

- Cut (8) 6 ½" WOF strips from the Background Fabric. Sub-cut each strip into (6) 6 ½" x 6 ½" squares for a total of 48.
- Cut all FQ's, scraps, or yardage into the following sizes of WOF strings/strips\*.



### Needed for Strings/Strips:

- Fat Quarters, or ¼ yards, or Yardage, or Scraps\* –  
 24 to 26 FQ's  
 approximately 6 to 6 ½ yds.)

**There will be leftover strings/strips after piecing your quilt.**
