DESCRIPTION: Create a dynamic design Kaleidoscope block while learning all the tricks of foundation paper piecing. In this workshop, all aspects of foundation paper piecing will be covered, including how to measure, cut, and correctly position the right fabric piece. By the time you are finished, Nancy will have helped you create this beautiful quilt top and you will leave with the confidence to tackle paper piecing again and again!

Be sure to bring the following pieces to class, along with the white, light-gray, and teal rectangles.

16 different orange rectangles

16 different black on white squares (should read as white)

32 different purple rectangles

16 different green rectangles

(Quilt size: 31½" x 31½" • Block size: 12")

Materials fee: \$13.00 for pattern & foundation papers

CLASS INSTRUCTION

Cutting for FOUR block:

From the white tone on tone, cut:

- 2 strips, 4" x 42"; crosscut into (16) 4" x 5" rectangles
- 4 strip, 2 ½" x 42"; crosscut into (32) 2 ½" x 5" rectangles

From each of 16 light gray prints, cut:

- (2) 3" x 4 ½" rectangle (32 total)

From each of 16 teal prints, cut:

- (1) 3" x 4" rectangle (16 total)
- (2) 1 ½" x 3 ½" rectangles (32 total)

SUPPLY LIST

Note: You can use my colors, choose your own colors, or use a monotone color scheme.

- ½ yard of white tone-on-tone
- (16) 3" x 4½" different orange rectangles
- (16) 3" x 3" different black-on-white squares (should read as white)
- (32) 3" x 3½" different purple rectangles
- (16) 3" x 4" different green rectangles
- (16) 4½" x 6" light gray rectangles
- (16) 4" x 6" teal rectangles
- Add-a-quarter ruler or 1" x 6" ruler
- Water soluble glue stick
- 6½" or larger square ruler
- Tools
- Rotary Cutter (45 mm or small cutter)
- Cutting Mat (12" x 18" or larger)
- Rulers:
- 6" x 12" ruler (or larger)
- 1" x 12" ruler or 12" Add-A-Quarter ruler
- Wooden Pressing tool
- Water soluble glue stick
- Basic sewing supplies (scissors, pins, wonder clips (optional), seam ripper, pencil, and any special tools you use)
- Finished block: 12" x 12"
