DESCRIPTION

The mountains are a perfect place to view beautiful scenery, with the rolling hills and delicate wildflowers along every path for this very unique project! Susan has created many different little fabric books from Italy to Alaska, her love of hand stitching, painting, collage, and collecting, all combines to create these little treasures. In this class she will walk you through creating landscapes, collage appliqué to create unusual textures. All of which will be lavished with hand embroidery techniques using hand-dyed fabrics, trims, and threads. This class will focus on the landscape and the mushrooms.

SUPPLY LIST

Items with Stars *** are needed for class, other items are optional.

- Extra fabrics to play with (small pieces, 8" pieces are plenty large enough. Solids and prints will work in different areas) Batiks are **not good for hand stitching**, but they are good to write on.
- ***Pearl Cotton Embroidery threads size #12, #8, #5, and #3 can all be used (these will be available to purchase from Susan's website, threads are not included in the kits) Floss with 6 strands does not work for most stitches.
- Buttons, trinkets, charms, beads, whatever you can sew on is fun!
- ***Scissors (embroidery scissors and paper scissors, kid Fiskars are good for paper)
- ***Sue Spargo's Creative Stitch Embroidery Book Or other embroidery book (available to purchase from Susan's website)
- Lace or trims
- ***Fabric Pen, Micron Pigma Pen (.05 or .08) or Non-Bleeding Sharpie
- ***Pins
- ***Pencils: regular lead pencil, Silver Artist Pencil or Chalk Pencil
- Small Sketch Book for sketching ideas or taking notes
