DESCRIPTION

Use 2 ½” strips to create this masterpiece. Class will include discussion on color placement, tips for accuracy, and how to piece this star with NO “Y” seams. Class goal is for each student to construct at least 1 quadrant of the star. Some students may complete more. Even if you plan to make the quilt as shown, you only need to cut for the topper for class.

***Pattern, ruler, and ruler arrows will be available for purchase in class**
Remember: You only need to cut for the topper for class.

SUPPLY LIST

- *Required Pattern: Quasar Plus
- *Required Ruler: Creative Grids® - CGR612 This is a basic 6 ½” x 12 ½” ruler that has all the marking needed to create this quilt.
- Ruler arrows: You must have something to mark lines on the ruler.
- Pre-cut fabric labeled by size.
- Colored pencils to plan color placement of your star(s)
- Your machine with foot pedal and power cord.
- Rotary cutter with fresh blade
- Cutting mat
- Straight pins, scissors, seam ripper and anything else you normally use when sewing
- Pencil for taking notes and marking as needed.
- Basic ruler for trimming and cutting.
- *A large square for squaring. CGR15 (basic 15 ½” square if you have one. If not, I will have one in class to share)
- 38” x 38” Topper 80” x 80” Quilt

(Note: you can add an additional border to the quilt to make a queen size quilt 88" x 88". You will need 1 ¼ yd not included in the yardage on the previous page in order to add this additional border. You would cut (9) 4 ½" x WOF strips)

If you plan to make the entire quilt and prefer to cut all at once, that information is provided.

Fabric	Cutting: () Topper []Quilt Refer to the brackets for the size you are making
Light Background ($\frac{2}{3}$ yd.), [2 $\frac{1}{4}$ yd.]	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut (1), [4] 10" x WOF strip cut into (4), [16] 10" squares • Cut (1), [4] 7 ½" x WOF strip cut into (4), [16] 7 ½" squares.
2 ½" strips (11), [43]	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • (10), [36] 2 ½" strips for star(s). • (1), [5] 2 ½" square(s) for cornerstones. <p>Quilt only: [6] additional 2 ½" strips for pieced border.</p>
Sashing and inner border ($\frac{1}{4}$ yd.), [1 ½ yd.]	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut (2), [19] 2 ½" x WOF strips. <p>Topper: Sub-cut (4) 2 ½" x 15 ½". Quilt: Sub-cut [4] 2 ½" squares, [16] 2 ½" x 15 ½" and [4] 2 ½" x 32 ½. Save the remainder for the inner border.</p>
Outer Border ($\frac{1}{2}$ yd.), [1yd.]	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut (4), [9] 3 ½" x WOF strips for outer border.
Binding ($\frac{1}{2}$ yd.), [$\frac{3}{4}$ yd.]	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut (4), [9] 2 ½" x WOF strips.
Backing (3 yd.) [8 yd. or 2 ½ yd. 108"]	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Topper: 46" x 46" • Quilt: 8 yd. or 2 ½ yd. 108" wide back <p>NOTE: If making the quilt larger by adding the additional border you will need 3 yd. 108"</p>

You may cut your own 2 ½" a WOF strips or use pre-cuts. I used 3 matching jelly rolls for this quilt so that I could pick and choose, and discard the light-colored strips.

Bring additional strips to class so you have options as we discuss color placement.
