There will be tons of embellishing techniques covered, different ways to use photo transfers & rubber-stamped images as well. The theme for your book can be based around a favorite fabric or a photo. Anything can be your theme, such as family, nature, or a pet. If you don't have a theme, Susan will help you come up with an idea! Vintage linens, laces, and buttons are always an added treasure for your book! There will be many hand embroidery techniques covered in this class too! So, if you love to embellish this is the class for you to learn some new tricks!

## SUPPLY LIST

- "Once Upon a Time" Pattern \$16.00 (available in class)
- Theme fabric for your idea (6" pieces are good) any color can even be a theme, or just an assortment of fabrics that work together are good
- 1/4 yd. or fat quarter of light color tonal fabric for story pages
- 5-6 other fabrics that coordinate with the Theme fabric (these could also be vintage fabrics as well)
- Lace, trim, rick rack, ribbon, etc. (small amounts, 6" is good)
- Buttons, beads, charms, old decorative fashion pins, any trinkets that can be sewn or glued on
- #12, #8 or #5 Pearl Cotton Embroidery thread & #22 Chenille needle
- Beading Thread & applique needle
- Photo transfers and/or rubber stamps with Fabrico/Versacraft Ink Pad (Susan will have some rubber stamps to share if you don't have any)
- Photo transferred Images using E-Q or Extrav-organza
- Fluffy yarn for edging (not necessary for class)
- Crayons (Crayola)
- Fabrico Pens (optional) Pigma Pens (size .05 or .08) Other Gel pens will work too & any scrap booking pens will work on fabric too (you will need one or two of these type of pens) The new "Non-Bleeding" Sharpie's work great!
- Kits available in class: \$35. See contents for kit below

\*\*\* Please do not stress over this supply list! Bring only small bits of fabrics & things, it is a small book but very fun to make & you can always add more when you get home to all your goodies! Susan will have hand dyed threads and trims for sale in class, and rubber stamps to share.
