

DESCRIPTION

Take a scenic journey to quilt paradise and learn how to make this cheerful and colorful scrappy design. If you have been wanting to master new skills, this workshop will inspire confidence and equip you with new techniques. Learn easy and precise methods for making the blocks. If scrappy is not for you, use a planned color scheme or make it patriotic.
(Quilt size: $85\frac{1}{4}$ " x $85\frac{1}{4}$ " ⇨ Block size: $11\frac{1}{4}$ " x $11\frac{1}{4}$ ")

Materials fee: \$13.00 for pattern & foundation papers

CLASS INSTRUCTION

Cutting - In class, you'll only have time to make a few blocks. How many you get done will depend on how fast you sew and your skill level. Cutting listed below is for making two Nine Patch Chain blocks and two Star blocks. A complete cutting list will be provided in class.

From the white solid, cut:

- 1 strip, 5" x 42"; crosscut into 8 squares, 5" x 5". Cut the squares twice diagonally to yield 32 A triangles. (You only need 8 A triangles for class.)
- 1 strip, $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x 42"; crosscut into 8 squares, $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x $4\frac{3}{4}$ ". (You only need 4 squares for class.)
- 1 strip, $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x 42"; crosscut into 9 squares, $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ " (You only need 8 squares for class.)
- 1 strip, $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x 42"; crosscut into 16 squares, $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x $2\frac{3}{8}$ " (You only need 8 squares for class.)
- 10 strips, $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 42"; crosscut into 20 strips, $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 21"

From each of the blue prints, cut:

- 1 strip, $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 21" (6 total)

From each of the purple prints, cut:

- 1 strip, $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 21" (6 total)

- 1 strip, $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 21" (6 total)

From each of the pink prints, cut:

- 1 strip, $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 21" (6 total)

From each of the orange prints, cut:

- 1 strip, $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 21" (6 total)

From the gold print, cut:

- 1 strip, 5" x 42"; crosscut into 8 squares, 5" x 5". Cut the squares twice diagonally to yield 32 triangles. (You only need 8 triangles for class.)

From each of 2 assorted prints, cut:

- 4 matching rectangles, $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " (8 total)

From the light-yellow print, cut:


- 1 strip, 5" x 42"; crosscut into 8 squares, 5" x 5". Cut the squares twice diagonally to yield 32 triangles. (You only need 16 triangles for class.)
- 1 strip, $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x 42"; crosscut into 8 squares, $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x $4\frac{3}{4}$ " (You only need 4 squares for class.)

From the assorted yellow prints, cut a total of:


- 2 squares, $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ "

SUPPLY LIST

- 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ yards of white solid for background
- 6 fat eighths of blue prints for Nine Patch Chain blocks
- 6 fat eighths of purple prints for Nine Patch Chain blocks
- 6 fat eighths of green prints for Nine Patch Chain blocks
- 6 fat eighths of pink prints for Nine Patch Chain blocks
- 6 fat eighths of orange prints for Nine Patch Chain blocks
- $\frac{5}{8}$ yard of gold print for Nine Patch Chain blocks
- 24 fat eighths of assorted prints for Star blocks
- 3 yards of light-yellow print for blocks and outer border
- 6 fat eighths of assorted yellow prints for Star blocks
- Rotary Cutter (45mm or small cutter)
- Cutting Mat (12" x 18" or larger)
- Rulers:
 - ♦ 6" x 12"
 - ♦ 1" x 12" ruler or 12" Add-A-Quarter ruler
- Water soluble glue stick
- Basic sewing supplies:
