

### DESCRIPTION


Wild and wonderful, you'll have a great time with this one! This Railroad Crossing pattern lets you travel through the land of color-play and contrast. ***Choo-choo! All aboard!*** Beginner friendly strip piecing becomes a whole new ride with the Wonky Ruler. So simple and so fun! The pattern, which will be provided in class, offers two project sizes *AND* two layout options. Of course, for this journey you must first choose your destination! Are you creating a wallhanging or a lap size quilt? Do you want to go to the Railroad Crossing (on the left above) or Grand Central Station (on the right)? Using the provided color sheets and examples, select fabrics and determine their placement for your chosen design layout. Simply cut fabric strips referring to the easy-to-follow chart! The fabric requirements and block piecing are the same for both layout options, so plan and cut without worry. We'll stay on track to learn how to piece, press, trim our blocks and assemble our layouts in class. See you at Quiltfest for the adventure!!

### SUPPLY LIST


- **Railroad Crossing Pattern. Grand Central Station is also included in this pattern! This will be provided for you in class and is included in your class fee.**
- **Sewing machine with manual, power cord and foot pedal**
- **1/4" presser foot (or what you typically use to achieve an accurate 1/4" seam)**
- **Thread to coordinate with your chosen fabrics**
- **Extra loaded bobbins**
- **Extension cord or power strip**
- **Extra machine needles**
- **Rotary mat, rotary cutter and extra blades**
- **Fabric scissors, thread clippers, seam ripper**
- **Straight pins and pin cushion**
- **Fabric marking pen or quilter's pencil**
  - **Note:** Bring the following rulers if you have them. **These rulers will be made available by your teacher for students in-class use; however, sharing may be necessary.**
- **12 1/2" Square Up ruler**


- o This ruler is available at [quiltinaday.com](http://quiltinaday.com). The 12 1/2" square up ruler is fairly standard and any acrylic rotary cutting ruler of similar type and size will suffice.
- **2 1/2" Strip Wonky Ruler**
  - o This ruler set is essential for the Railroad Crossing and Grand Central Station pattern construction. It can be found at [quiltinaday.com](http://quiltinaday.com). Your teacher will have some available in class for student use and for sale at a discounted price to students.

## Fabric Cutting Chart

Fabric requirements and block piecing are the same for Railroad Crossing and Grand Central Station layout options.

Strip = a strip of fabric cut from selvage to selvage, approx. 42".

Colors on the chart correspond with color placement on the pattern's front cover to the left.

Wallhanging	Lap
34" x 41"	50" x 65"
4 x 5 = 20 blocks	6 x 8 = 48 blocks

<b>Center</b>	<b>1/4 yard</b> (2) 2 1/2" strips	<b>1 1/4 yard</b> (3) 2 1/2" strips
<b>Side Rectangles</b>	<b>5/8 yard</b> (4) 4 1/4" strips (4) 2 1/2" strips	<b>1 5/8 yards</b> (6) 4 1/4" strips (11) 2 1/2" strips
<b>Corners #1</b>	<b>1/2 yard</b> (4) 4 1/4" strips	<b>1 1/2 yards</b> (11) 4 1/4" strips
<b>Corners #2</b>	<b>1/2 yard</b> (4) 4 1/4" strips	<b>1 1/2 yards</b> (11) 4 1/4" strips
<b>Border</b>	<b>1/3 yard</b> (4) 2 1/2" strips	<b>1 yard</b> (6) 5" strips
<b>Binding</b>	<b>3/8 yard</b> (4) 2 3/4" strips	<b>1/2 yard</b> (6) 2 3/4" strips
<b>Backing</b>	<b>1 1/3 yards</b>	<b>3 1/4 yards</b>
<b>Batting</b>	42" x 49"	58" x 73"
