

CLASS DESCRIPTION:

Scrappy or more planned, this quilted wallhanging is gorgeous! Learn some simple block piecing techniques with this beginner friendly pattern. We'll create four elementary block units, make two block styles, to create this fancy "Oh, I worked so hard!" looking design. Our Roundabout Stars pattern guides us through the most efficient piecing and pressing to get the most successful results for our effort. The pattern will be provided in class and is included in your class fee. Come have fun and make something beautiful!

SUPPLY LIST




- Roundabout Stars Quilt Pattern. This will be provided for you in class and is included in your class fee.
- Sewing machine with manual, power cord and foot pedal
- ¼" presser foot (or what you typically use to achieve an accurate ¼" seam)
- Thread to coordinate with your chosen fabrics
- Extra loaded bobbins
- Extension cord or power strip
- Extra machine needles
- Rotary mat, rotary cutter and extra blades
- Fabric scissors, thread clippers, seam ripper
- Straight pins and pin cushion
- Fabric marking pen or quilter's pencil
- 6" Square Up Ruler
- 6 ½" Triangle Square Up ruler or 4 ½" Fussy Cut Ruler
- Triangle in a Square Ruler
 - This ruler set is essential for the triangle-in-a-square piecing method used in this project. It can be found at quiltinaday.com. Your teacher will have some available in class for student use and for sale at a discounted price to students.

Optional: Creative Grids Stripology Ruler can increase efficiency when cutting repetitive units.




these rulers, such as the 6" square up ruler, are fairly standard and any acrylic rotary cutting ruler of similar type will suffice.

Quilt in a Day® Roundabout Stars

Fabric Cutting Chart

These fabric requirements are for a scrappy version. Refer to your coloring sheet and adjust for a more planned version.

Strip = a strip of fabric cut from selvage to selvage, approx. 42".

Wallhanging

53" x 53"

Nine 12" Stars

Background	1 1/2 yards
Half Square Triangles	(3) 5 1/2" strips cut into (8) 5 1/2" x 11" rectangles
Triangles in a Square	(4) 5" strips
Pieced Border Squares	(1) 4 1/2" strip cut into (4) 4 1/2" squares
Four-Patches	(4) 2 1/2" strips cut into (16) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles
Medium	16 Fat Eighths or Scraps
Half Square Triangles	(8) 5 1/2" x 11" scrappy rectangles
Star Centers	(9) 4 1/2" scrappy squares
Four-Patches	(16) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" scrappy rectangles
Dark	11 Fat Eighths or Scraps
Star Points	(11) 6" x 14" scrappy rectangles
Border	1 yard (6) 5" strips
Binding	5/8 yard (6) 3" strips
Backing	3 1/2 yards
Batting	60" x 60"
