DESCRIPTION

Create a dynamic design with this off-center Pineapple block while learning all the tricks of foundation paper piecing. All aspects of foundation paper piecing will be covered, including how to measure, cut, and correctly position the right fabric piece. By the time you are finished, Nancy will have helped you create this beautiful wild quilt top and you will leave with the confidence to tackle paper piecing again and again! (Quilt size: 60½" x 60½" ♦ Block size: 8" x 8")

CLASS INSTRUCTION

Cutting

Cutting listed below is for the entire quilt. In class, you'll only have time to make one or two blocks. How many you get done will depend on how fast you sew and how proficient you are at paper foundation piecing. If desired, you can bring about the number of pieces listed under "Cutting for Two Blocks." Complete materials and cutting will be provided in class

From the light background, cut:

- (54) 2 ¼" x 42" strips; cut into:
 - (144) 2 ¼" x 3" rectangles
 - (144) 2 ¼" x 4 ½" rectangles
 - (144) 2 ¼" x 6 ½" rectangles

From the assorted blue prints, cut a total of:

- (108) 3" x 5" rectangles
- (36) 2 ½" squares

From the assorted green prints, cut a total of:

- (54) 3 ¼" squares; cut in half diagonally to yield 108 triangles
- (54) 4 ¼" squares; cut in half diagonally to yield 108 triangles

Cutting for TWO blocks:

From the light background, cut:

- (8) 2 ¼" x 3" rectangles
- (8) 2 ¼" x 4 ½" rectangles
- (8) 2 ¼" x 6 ½" rectangles

From the assorted blue prints, cut:

- (6) 3" x 5" rectangles
- (2) 2 ½" squares

From the assorted green prints, cut:

- (3) 3 1/4" squares; cut in half diagonally to yield 6 triangles
- (3) 4 1/4" squares; cut in half diagonally to yield 6 triangles



SUPPLY LIST

- 4 yards of light background fabric
- 14 fat eighths (9" x 22") of assorted green prints 16 fat eighths (9" x 22") of assorted blue prints

Tools

- Rotary Cutter (45 mm or small cutter)
- Cutting Mat (12" x 18" or larger)
- Rulers:
 - o 6" x 12" ruler (or larger)
 - o 1" x 12" ruler or 12" Add-A-Quarter ruler
- Wooden Pressing tool
- Water soluble glue stick
- Basic sewing supplies: scissors, pins, wonder clips (optional), seam ripper, pencil, and any special tools you use.
