These guidelines will describe the available categories for entry and provide you with an entry form for each of your submissions. There is NO LIMIT to the number of quilts that can be submitted. Please follow the instructions carefully. Quilts may be submitted in person during specified quilt take-in times or through the mail.

**Mailed** in entries must be postmarked by: **Monday, May 4, 2026** UPS, FEDEX, or USPS ONLY.

For those wishing to **hand deliver** their entries in person the dates are **Friday, May 15, from 10:00 am - 2:00 pm** or **Saturday, May 16, from 10:00 am - 1:00 pm ONLY at the Pigeon Forge Office of Special Events, located at 3107 Parkway, Pigeon Forge**. Please be aware there will most likely be heavy traffic in Pigeon Forge so please allow for plenty of time to arrive at the office within the designated time frame. *Additionally, quilts will not be accepted after 1:00 pm on Saturday, May 16.*

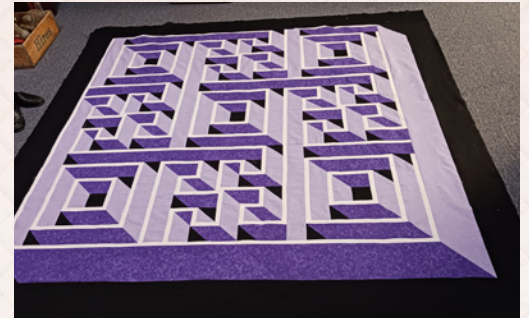
# THEME QUILTS

## 2026 THEME QUILT: OPTICAL ILLUSIONS

An Optical Illusion themed quilt uses fabric manipulation to create the illusion of depth, movement or hidden images. The quilt may use color contrast, pattern scale and texture to trick the viewer's eye. The design plays tricks with the eyes and can trick our brains into seeing things that are not real, because of the way our brains process information from our eyes.

Quilters have been using angles, shading, and perspective to produce the illusion of three dimensional depth for generations.

To qualify for the theme category, the quilt must use color, tone, and shape to produce the optical illusion of depth. The category will be divided into large and small quilts. A large quilt will have a perimeter of 250 inches or larger. A small quilt will have a perimeter of less than 250 inches. These 2 categories are exempt from the Quilted by Another Restriction. Prizes will be awarded for both Large and Small Theme Quilt categories.

## 2027 THEME QUILT: CIRCLE THIS!

The theme for 2027 is Circle This! Circles must be the predominant feature of the entry.

Circles play a vital role to the quilt making process in two distinct ways. Circles represent social connections or circles such as quilting bees and quilting circles. In various traditions, circles represent the soul or the “circle of life”.

Several historical patterns rely on the circle to create their iconic looks such as the Dresden Plate and the Mariner's Compass. This theme offers a contemporary nod to the legacy of the “quilting circle” by creating a historical symbol into a featured design element.

Certified quilt appraiser, **Cynthia (Cindy) Stuart**, will again provide professional quilt appraisals for anyone wishing to have their quilts appraised. Quilt appraisals will be available by appointment only on June 8-11 2026.

Cindy is a quilt historian who began quilting in the 1990s and became interested in quilt restoration after repairing a wedding quilt for her mother. In order to restore quilts, one must learn how to date fabrics and use quilting techniques consistent with those used in the past.

Cindy will be providing appraisals by appointment only. Cindy will provide you with all of the necessary paperwork and schedule your appointment.

All appraisals will be conducted in private at the LeConte Event Center at Pigeon Forge. Please inquire at the Information Desk when you arrive for directions to the appraisal room. If you have not made a prior appointment, but would like to see if Cindy can work you in, contact her directly at the number listed above.

The appraisal fee for **one quilt is \$60**. Verbal consultations are \$25/each.

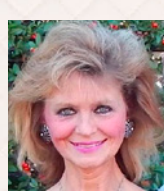

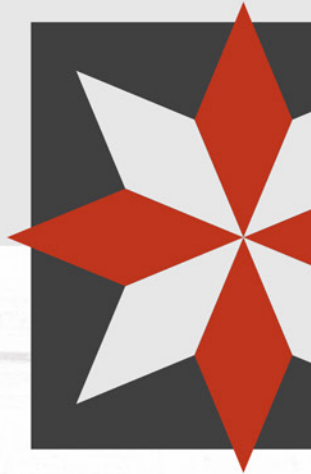

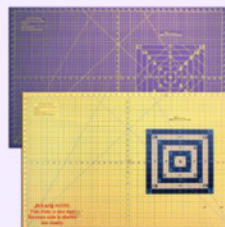
